



HSA SKEET – TRAP

- 1 – Hearing and Eye protection is required on all ranges
- 2 – Actions open and empty when not shooting; Muzzle in a safe direction; and finger off of the trigger until ready to fire.
- 3 - Shot Size: Skeet: Size 8 or 9 shot

 Trap: Maximum is Number 7 1/2
- 4 – Shot shell velocities should not exceed 2 ¾ dram equivalent – 1200 feet per second muzzle velocity.
- 5 – Two (2) rounds in the firearm is the maximum allowed
- 6 – All rounds are to be paid for prior to shooting.
 One Round = 25 clays
- 7 – When the ranges are open, there two (2) Skeet Committee Personnel on duty who responsible for scheduling the flow of Shooting. When a shooter has completed a round, the shooter should return to the skeet house and sign up for the next available squad. Paying in advance, then joining a squad without the knowledge of the committee person in charge is prohibited,
- 8 – It would be helpful to all if the shooters pick up their empty shells at the completion of their round.
